Context:

Understanding the environmental complexity and other dimensions of ecological systems requires a holistic approach that can only be achieved by identifying, retrieving and synthesizing diverse data from distributed sources; collaborating with other scientists from a wide range of disciplines; and investigating many different systems. Given the growing demand for economically and socially sustainable solutions to complex and urgent environmental problems, multi- and trans-disciplinary studies are essential and particularly feasible when there is a wealth of reliable scientific data and information. In this scenario, centers of analysis and synthesis appear as effective and indispensable tools for gauging and integrating data, often bringing new value to the knowledge generated regionally, thus facilitating the use of this knowledge for the elaboration of effective public policies and generation of solutions. Within this context, the general objective of this proposal is to structure in Brazil the Center of Synthesis in Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services, focused on the production of high-impact scientific syntheses on issues related to biodiversity and associated ecosystem services. Three phases are planned for the organization of the Center: implementation, simplified structure, consolidated structure. The first two phases will be covered by this proposal with workshops for the scientific community and funding agencies, visits to consolidated international centers, structuring of the Center's management unit and preparation of subsidies for the first public call for synthesis.
